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
Assembly Constraints


New implementation of constraint-based component positioning

Replaces NX 4 "mating conditions"

- Easier to use
- More efficient
- More consistent with sketcher

First available in NX 5







Transitioning Mating Conditions → **Assembly Constraints**





Constraint conversion

Benefits of converting constraints

NX 6 provides good support for working in assemblies with mixed constraint types

However, improved user experience if only assembly constraints exist








Constraint conversion

Benefits of converting constraints

User sees benefits of assembly constraints with every assembly User only has to understand one constraints system and UI Dynamic dragging available in all assemblies

No need to switch UI for older assemblies
 Assembly sequencing only recognises
 one constraint type at a time






Using refile_part for bulk constraint conversion

Option	Capability	
-convert_mcs	Enables constraint conversion during refile & generates conversion report	
Additional options (NX 6.0.1):		
-mc_parts_only	Only refile parts that contain constraints	
-mc_dry_run	Convert constraints & generate report without saving any parts	
-mc_dont_load_referenced geometry	Do not force load parts containing referenced geometry (conversion not checked)	



Recommended refile process






Conversion checking process

Steps taken by NX during interactive conversion and refile_part:

- 1. Solve using *mating conditions* & remember component positions
- 2. Convert constraints
- 3. Solve using assembly constraints
- 4. Compare new and old component positions
- 5. For components that would be moved:
 - a. do not apply reposition
 - b. suppress constraints causing movement



Customer defaults to specify allowable movement
